3. **Set the scene:** Decide where and when your story happens. Describe it a little to help readers imagine.

4. **Plan the story:** Make a list of what will happen in your story. Think of problems or challenges for your characters.
5. **Start strong:** Begin with an interesting start to grab attention. Introduce your main characters.
6. **Build up the story:** Make things more exciting by adding problems. Think about what your characters do to solve them.
7. **Make a big moment:** Have a part where everything is very exciting. This is the most important part of your story.
8. **Sort things out:** Fix the main problem in your story. Start calming down the excitement.
9. **End it well:** Finish your story in a way that makes sense. Say what happens to your characters in the end.
10. **Make it sound good:** Use nice words to make your story more interesting. You may include conversations.
11. **Check and fix:** Take a break, then read your story again. Fix any mistakes and make sure it makes sense, then write your clean copy.
12. **Give it a name:** Choose a title that fits your story.
